

1878. The 1880 census records show that they were living in Fulton County, GA near Atlanta. Junious moved to Mississippi in the 1890's with children Dan, John, and Tacki. They settled in the Winston/Choctaw area. Harriet had married in 1883. Harriet Norwood Bradford m- 22 Jun 1883 to Fortune Montgomery in Michell County, GA noting else is known about them. Mary Molly Norwood Bradford may have died some time between 1890 and 1898 or possibly before that. This is a guess on my part as there are no 1890 Census records due to them being destroyed by water. Nor can I find any record of her death.

In 1899, Junious married Eliza Catherine "Katie" McKay - Ivy after their marriage they, with her two children, Lucy Belle and John Doss Jr., moved to the Wier, Ms area sometime in 1900. They lived in the Wier area until 1909 or 1910, they then moved to Leake County, Ms. They first lived about 1.50 miles west of the Freeny Community, they they bought a place and moved to the Estes Mill Community between Carthage and Walnut Grove MS where they farmed. Junious died there in 1920 and is buried at the New Hope cemetery. Eliza Catherine continued to maintain a home there until her death on 21 Jun 1962. She is buried alongside Junious in the New Hope Cemetery. New Hope Cemetery is a half mile west of Estes Mill.
