- 3f4 Linquir [ Jenny - Lenny ] Ivy, daughter of William Thomas Ivy, b- April 1889 in 1900 she was age 11. she was 21 years old in 1910 and living at home with her parents there is nothing else on her after 1910
- 3f5 Nancy C. Ivy, daughter of William Thomas Ivy, b- 2 Dec 1890 Winston County, MS d- 31 Aug 1891 Winston County, MS buried Bevil Hill Cemetery Winston County, MS
- 3f6 Josiah Ivy, son of William Thomas Ivy, b- 27 Dec 1892 Webster, Winston, MS. At age 25 he was registered for the WW 1 civilian draft. Nothing else is know about him at this time.
- 3f7 Cabot U. Ivy, son of William Thomas Ivy, b- 31 May 1898 Winston County, MS d- 8 Aug 1899 Winston County, MS buried Bevil Hill Cemetery Winston County, MS
- 3f8 William Patterson, grandson of Catherine Ivy, b- 1915 d- unk. Father and Mother Unk Lived with Catherine in 1930 at age 15 in Webster, Winston, MS nothing else is known about him.
- 3f9 Nancy Ann Ivy, daughter of Jesse H. Ivy, b- 13 Jun 1851 Winston County, MS d- 31 May 1938 Winston County, MS burial Bevil Hill, Winston, MS m- Feb 1870 to Mathias Rush McKay b- 23 Jul 1849 Franklin County, Al d-23 Mar 1898 Betheden, Winston, MS burial Bevil Hill Cemetery, Winston County, MS [ see A Bloody Battle article at the end of the book] I am only listing one of their descendants Eliza Catherine McKay she married her first cousin John Doss Ivy.
- 4 Samuel Lewis Ivy, son of Zachariah Ivy, b- 1820 South Carolina m- 29 Feb 1848 to Margaret Ann Harril [ Hamill ? ] b- 1825 Alabama. Married in Winston County, MS two daughters. He served in the Civil War in the Confederate States Army, he enlisted in Co. " F" 5th Regiment, Mississippi State Troops on 21 [ or 24] Aug 1862 in Louisville, Winston, Miss. He was made a prisoner of war by the Yankees after the fall and surrender of Vicksburg, MS on 4 Jul 1864 and was paroled at Vicksburg, Miss on 10 Jul 1863 and was mustered out of the Army on 22 Sep 1863 by order of Gen. Jos. E. Johnston and was paid \$155.58 on 3 Nov 1863
- 4a1 Parmelia Ann Ivy, a.k.a. Melia A. Ammons, daughter of Sam L. Ivy, b- 1848 Winston County, MS d- 16 Apr 1934 Longworth, Fisher, Texas m- 16 May 1880 Van Zant County, TX to William Franklin Ammons b- 18 May 1850 Navasota, TX d- 8 Dec 1939 Longworth, TX. One son John Wesley Ammons
- 4a1a John Wesley Ammons, son of Parmelia Ivy/Ammons, b- 7 Sep 1885 Van Zant County, TX d- 18 Mar 1959 Sweetwater, Nolan, TX. m- Ona Frances Brewer 27 Dec 1908 b- 26 Jan 1889 Van Zant County, TX d- 14 Jun 1944 Roby, Fisher, TX Ten Children
